"Grades 1-5: Teachers will record completion of selected learning opportunities using numerical grades. All grades will be weighted equally as daily grades. Yearly averages will be calculated using the first, second, third, and fourth nine-weeks grades. Any missing assignments for the 4th nine-weeks will be accepted without penalty through Friday, May 22, 2020. However, until missing assignments are submitted, a zero will be recorded in the gradebook. New assignments will not be given during the week of May 25."

ALL assignments continue to be due on Mondays at 8:00 a.m. I highly recommend that students continue with their home schedules on completing the work prior to Mondays at 8:00 a.m. to avoid them falling behind on assignments. The last thing we want is for a student to wait and then have too many assignments to complete before the penalty free timeline of May 22nd.

Modes of communication: our teachers are ready and responsible for communicating with you once a week to support students in completing assignments. The modes of communication: 1. e-mail 2. Remind (text) 3. voice call 4. TEAMS (virtual assistance). If you have preference, please communicate that with your child's teacher.
